This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the drilling of the Sharp 2 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired July 9, 2008. This extension will expire April 15, 2009. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the Closure of Surface Pit form.

Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date may result in a fine in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional extension will only be granted for good cause and after K.C.C. field staff has made an inspection of the site. Should field staff discover that said pit has been closed before the date of extension request, an administrative penalty may be assessed to you through K.C.C. invoice.

Ritchie Exploration, Inc. requests a 90-day pit closure extension, from the January 9th, 2009 expiration date, to April 9th, 2009; due to extremely wet weather conditions in this area over the last year.

The well was spud July 9th, 2007, and Dry & Abandoned on July 19th, 2007. Partial backfills of the drilling pits were performed on August 22nd, 2007, and again on August 20th, 2008. On December 29th, 2008, rain water was removed from the pits, and partially backfilled down to an area of only 30' x 50' remaining. We have been in contact with the landowner throughout the process, and is supportive of our efforts.
