The above referenced work-over pit was permitted on 9/5/2008. Work-over pits shall be closed within 365 calendar days after work-over operations have commenced. The work-over pit in question must be closed by 9/5/2009. Should an exception be warranted, it must be received by 9/5/2009.

A Closure of Surface Pit, form CDP-4, should be filed within 30 days after the work-over pits are closed. Conservation division forms are available through our office and on the KCC web site: http://kcc.ks.gov/conservation/forms/. Failure to timely close the pit, file an extension or file the form within the allotted time periods may be punishable by an administrative penalty.
