(2	requi	dispose of reserve pit waste down the annular space of a well completed according to the alternate requirements of K.A.R. 82-3-106, if the waste to be disposed of was generated during the drilling an completion of the well; or		
(3		se of the remaining solid contents in any manner required by the commission. The requirements may de any of the following:		
	(A)	Burial in place, in accordance with the grading and restoration requirements in K.A.R. 82-3-602 (f);		
	(B)	removal and placement of the contents in an on-site disposal area approved by the commission;		
	(C)	removal and placement of the contents in an off-site disposal area on acreage owned by the same landowner or to another producing lease or unit operated by the same operator, if prior written permission from the landowner has been obtained; or		
	(D)	removal of the contents to a permitted off-site disposal area approved by the department.

Dear L. D. Davis:

District staff has inspected the above referenced location and has determined that the Haul-Off pit shall be constructed **without slots**, the bottom shall be flat and reasonably level and the free fluids must be removed. The fluids are to be removed from the Haul-Off pit as soon as the Hutchinson Salt section has been drilled through and displacement of the fluids into the Haul-Off pit has occurred. The fluids should be removed again within 96 hours after drilling operations have ceased. Fluids must also be removed after each well.

NO completion fluids or non-exempt wastes shall be placed in the Haul-Off pit.

The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well. Please call the District Office at (620) 225-8888 when the fluids have been removed. Form CDP-5 (August 2004), Exploration and Production Waste Transfer, must be filed within 30 days of fluid removal.
