District staff has reviewed the above referenced location and has determined the pit must be **lined and fluids removed after completion**. A plastic liner with the minimum thickness of **6 mil** is to be used. Integrity of the liner must be maintained at all times.

The fluids must be removed from the pit after workover operations have ceased. The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well. Please call the District Office at (785) 625-0550 when the fluids have been removed. Please file form CDP-5 (April 2004), Exploration and Production Waste Transfer, within 30 days of fluid removal. Conservation division forms are available through our office and on the KCC web site: www.kcc.state.ks.us/conservation/forms.
