
This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the drilling of the Laughan 2A well.

The original 365 days for closure expired December 18, 2007. This extension will expire March 18, 2008. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the Closure of Surface Pit form.

Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date may result in a fine in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(c). An additional extension will only be granted for good cause and after K.C.C. field staff has made an inspection of the site. Should field staff discover that said pit has been closed before the date of extension request, an administrative penalty may be assessed to you through K.C.C. invoice.

For some reason, the drilling contractor on this well left the rig for almost a year. Many reasons were given for the delay. After the rig was finally removed and the location was restored by Kenny's Dozer Service, he could not yet fill the pits completely due to weather. This location is in a ravine and Kenny is trying to close them as he can with the weather permitting. Any kind of rain or melting snow drains a lot of water back into the pits. At this time the pits are nearly closed and should be completely closed soon. You may verify this information by contacting Kenny's Dozer Service. The above referenced well was spudded on 12/18/2006. According to K.A.R. 82-3-602, "Drilling pits ... shall be closed within a maximum of 365 calendar days after the spud date of a well". The subject drilling pits should have been closed by 12/18/2007. A Closure of Surface Pit, form CDP-4 (April 2004), should be filed within 30 days after the drilling pits are closed. **Conservation division forms are available through our office and on the KCC web site: <http://kcc.ks.gov/conservation/forms/>**
