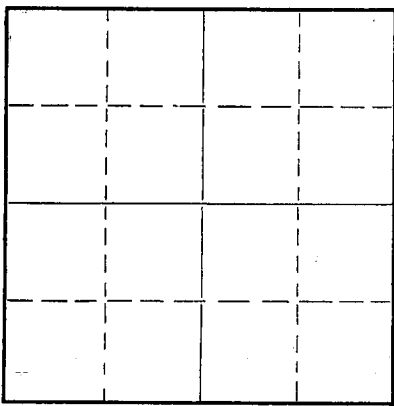

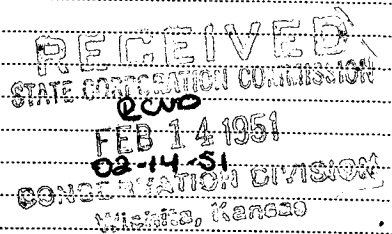

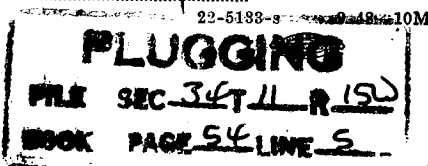

2. All material will be subject to our inspection and approval. If rejected, same will be held subject to your instructions, at your risk, and returned, at your expense.
3. No charge for packing and cartage will be allowed unless agreed to in advance.
4. On freight shipments routing specified by Carter shall be used. Otherwise, any extra expense will be charged to shipper. If not otherwise specified, ship via cheapest way.
5. This order must not be filled without authority from Carter at a higher price than last quoted.
6. Carter assumes no responsibility in respect of verbal orders given by employees outside of its Purchasing Department.
7. Seller represents and warrants that applicable provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended, have been complied with in respect to the material listed hereon.
8. Seller warrants that the use or sale by Carter of materials specified herein will not subject it to charges for patent infringement; it further agrees to hold Carter harmless from any and all claims arising from such charges.

#### B. WHERE THIS ORDER COVERS LABOR OR SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED RECIPIENT AGREES AS FOLLOWS:
