District staff has reviewed the above referenced location and has determined the pit must **be lined and fluids removed within after completion**. A plastic liner with the minimum thickness of **6 mil** is to be used. Integrity of the liner must be maintained at all times.

The fluids must be removed from the pit within 72 hours after completion of workover operations. The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well.
