The assessment for plugging all wells is one cent per foot, with a maximum of \$25.00 and a minimum of \$5.00.

STATE CORPORATION COMMISSION RULES AND REGULATIONS:

306....."The owner or operator of a plugged well shall pay to the Commission on or before thirty days from the date of plugging, one cent per foot of well depth plugged; Provided, that the maximum charge shall be \$25 and the Minimum \$5; Provided, that this rule shall not apply to the plugging of holes as described in Rule 304"- (Seismic, Core and Other Exploratory Holes).

GENERAL STATUTES FOR 1935, 55-132....."Any person, owner or operator violating any of the provisions of this act shall, upon conviction thereof, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined in the sum of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the county jail of not more than six (6) months, or be subject to both fine and imprisonment."

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
