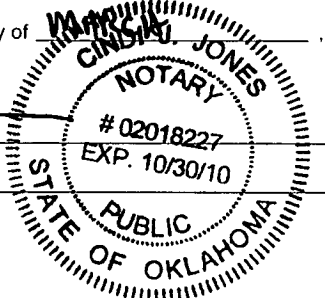

GEOLOGICAL REPORT

ELM CREEK 7-2

SECTION 7 - T25S - R23W

FORD COUNTY, KANSAS

INTRODUCTION

The above captioned well was drilled to a total depth of 5,550 feet on January 7, 2010. A one-man logging unit was on location from approximately 2,000 feet to TD. The well was under the geological supervision of the undersigned from approximately 4,000 feet to TD. At TD, Weatherford electric logs were run that consisted of Dual Induction, Compensated Neutron-Density, Micro-log, and Sonic log. From data collected while drilling and analyzing, potential hydrocarbon shows were encountered in the Chase Dolomite, the Mississippian Detrital and Spergen/Warsaw Dolomites. Drill stem tests were run on both intervals. The results indicated the dolomites to be "wet" with the Detrital most likely being productive. The decision was made to set pipe and attempt completion in the Mississippian Detrital. The Chase Dolomite should be evaluated at a later date.

CHASE DOLOMITE

The Chase was topped at 2,440 (-84), with a porosity zone being cut at 2,450 (-94) feet. Samples were described as tan to light gray, friable sucrosic dolomite with some pin-point porosity being observed. The gas chromatograph recorded 36 and 42 unit gas kicks through a 20-foot zone. Electric logs indicate a 20-foot zone of 18% porosity that could have hydrocarbons. This zone should be tried before abandonment of the well.

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WICHITA, KS

MISSISSIPPIAN

The Mississippian Detrital was tagged at 4,692 (-2336) feet. Samples were described as a conglomerate made up of tan to cream-buff limestone, along with opaque cherts and unconsolidated, fine grained, frosty to clear sand grains. Porosities ranged from intercrystalline and intergranular to pin-point and vugular. A bright yellow mineral fluorescence along with a slow streaming cut and brown live oil staining was observed. Electric logs indicate an eight-foot zone of 18% porosity that calculates productive. A drill stem test was run to further evaluate this interval with results as follows:

DST#1 (4634 - 4750) 30-60-60-120

Recovery: 65' slightly oil cut mud 15% oil

FP: 32-39/42-53

SIP: 702/1143

The test was slightly "tight", but should have decent quantities of hydrocarbons.

The Mississippian Unconformity was cut at 4,703 (-2347). The Spergen Dolomite was cut at 4,748 (-2392) feet and was not too well developed. Samples were described as white to off-white, cream tan, very fine to fine crystalline dolomite with good pin-point and vugular porosity being observed. A trace of live oil staining, dull yellow fluorescence with no cut and gas bubbles was reported. Gas kicks of 94, 103 and 102 units were recorded from the gas chromatograph. These most likely were also part trip gas from DST #1. Drill stem test #2 was run to evaluate this zone, with results as follows:

DST#2 (4750 - 4775) 30-60-60-120

Recovery: 65' slightly water cut mud

65' mud cut water

FP: 22-45/46-86

SIP: 1488/1493

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BERGEN SANDSTONE

The Bergen, which lies on top of the Arbuckle, was cut at 5,360 (-3004) feet. Samples were described as white, clear to opaque, very fine to fine grained, consolidated shale imbedded sandstone, good intergranular porosity being observed. No shows were observed. Electric logs indicate a total of ten feet of 12% porosity rock.

ARBUCKLE DOLOMITE

The Arbuckle was topped at 5,378 (-3022) feet. Samples were described as off-white to cream tan buff, very fine crystalline glauconitic dolomite with a very good sucrosic texture and very good intercrystalline porosity being seen. No sample shows were observed. Electric logs indicate a 12-foot zone of 20% porosity that could calculate productive. Due to the structural nature of the Elm Creek 7-2, a drill stem test was run to further evaluate the Bergen Sand and Arbuckle Dolomite, with results as follows:

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS: In these terms and conditions, "ALLIED" shall mean Allied Cementing Co., LLC, and "CUSTOMER" shall refer to the party identified by that term on the front of this contract. As applicable, "Job" relates to the services described on the front side of this contract, "Merchandise" refers to the material described on the front of this contract and to any other materials, products, or supplies used, sold, or furnished under the requirements of this contract.

—**TERMS:** Unless satisfactory credit has been established, CUSTOMER must tender full cash payment to ALLIED before the job is undertaken or merchandise is delivered. If satisfactory credit has been established, the terms of payment for the job and/or merchandise, including bulk cement, are net cash, payable in 30 days from the completion of the job and/or delivery of the merchandise. For all past due invoices, CUSTOMER agrees to pay interest on amounts invoiced at a rate of 18 percent per annum until paid. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in no event shall this Contract provide for interest exceeding the maximum rate of interest that CUSTOMER may agree to pay under applicable law. If any such interest should be provided for, it shall be and hereby is deemed to be a mistake, and this contract shall be automatically reformed to lower the rate of interest to the maximum legal contract rate, any amounts previously paid as excess interest shall be deducted from the amounts owing from the CUSTOMER or at the option of ALLIED, refunded directly to CUSTOMER. For purposes of this paragraph, ALLIED and CUSTOMER agree that Kansas law shall apply. Any discounts granted with this contract are null and void if the charges are not paid when due.

—**ATTORNEY FEES:** In any legal action or proceeding between the parties to enforce any of the terms of this Service Contract, or in any way pertaining to the terms of this Contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover all expenses, including, but not limited to, a reasonable sum as and for attorney's fees.

—**PRICES AND TAXES:** All merchandise listed in ALLIED'S current price schedule are F.O.B. ALLIED'S local station and are subject to change without notice. All prices are exclusive of any federal, state, local, or special taxes for the sale or use of the merchandise or services listed. The amount of taxes required to be paid by ALLIED shall be added to the quoted prices charged to CUSTOMER.

—**TOWING CHARGES:** ALLIED will make a reasonable attempt to get to and from each job site using its own equipment. Should ALLIED be unable to do so because of poor or inadequate road conditions, and should it become necessary to employ a tractor or other pulling equipment to get to or from the job site, the tractor or pulling equipment will be supplied by CUSTOMER or, if furnished by ALLIED, will be charged to and paid by CUSTOMER.

—**PREPARATION CHARGES:** If a job and/or merchandise is ordered and CUSTOMER cancels the order after preparation of a chemical solution or other material, CUSTOMER will pay ALLIED for the expenses incurred by ALLIED as a result of the cancellation.

—**DEADHAUL CHARGES:** Unless otherwise specified on the front of this Contract, a deadhaul charge as set forth in ALLIED'S current price book will be charged each way for each service unit which is ordered by CUSTOMER but not used.

—SERVICE CONDITIONS AND LIABILITIES:

1. ALLIED carries public liability and property damage insurance, but since there are so many uncertain and unknown conditions beyond ALLIED'S control, ALLIED shall not be liable for injuries to property or persons or for loss or damage arising from the performance of the job or delivery of the merchandise. CUSTOMER shall be responsible for and indemnify, defend, and hold harmless ALLIED, its officers, agents and employees, from and against any and all claims or suits for:

(A) Damage to property or for bodily injury, sickness, disease, or death, brought by any person, including CUSTOMER and/or the well owner; and:

(B) Oil spills, pollution, surface or sub-surface damage, injury to the well, reservoir loss, or damage arising from a well blowout arising out of or in connection with ALLIED'S performance of the job or furnishing of merchandise in accordance with this contract, unless such loss or damage is caused by the willful misconduct or gross negligence of ALLIED or its employees.

2. With respect to any of ALLIED'S tools, equipment, or instruments which are lost in the well or damaged when performing or attempting to perform the job or, in the case of marine operations, are lost or damaged at any time after delivery to the landing for CUSTOMER and before return to ALLIED at the landing, CUSTOMER shall either recover the lost item without cost to ALLIED or reimburse ALLIED the current replacement cost of the item unless the loss or damage results from the sole negligence of ALLIED or its employees.

3. ALLIED does not assume any liability or responsibility for damages or conditions resulting from chemical action in cements caused by contamination of water or other fluids.

WARRANTIES:

1. ALLIED warrants all merchandise manufactured or furnished by it to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service when installed, and used, and/or serviced in the manner provided and intended. ALLIED'S obligation under this warranty is expressly limited to repair, replacement, or allowance for credit, at its option, for any merchandise which is determined by ALLIED to be defective.
