Dear Ms Flaharty:

Thank you for your follow-up letter concerning documentation for our cathodic protection wells. It was my misunderstanding concerning the required forms to be filed. Enclosed are the CDP-5 forms that you requested for the wells. As you suggested, I have indicated on each form that drilling material was vacuumed into a steel storage tank for later disposal.

Please note that decanted drilling water from the tank has already been removed and reused in a process water stream sent to the gasifier. The remaining solids in the tank will continue to dewater and dry. As soon as the material is dry enough, samples will be taken and analyzed in order to determine a suitable disposal method. We anticipate that this will be in a non-hazardous landfill. When disposal has been completed, another set of CDP-5 forms will be submitted.

I hope that the completed forms being submitted will be sufficient for now. Please let me know if any additional information is required.
