American Energies Corporation has been asked by the Kansas Corporation Commission, KCC, office in Wichita, Kansas, to provide them with written evidence of your approval for AEC to dispose of the cuttings and drilling mud produced in connection with American's drilling of the Blank # 1-22 test well located in the S/2 NE/4 Section 22-28S-6W, Kingman County, Kansas.
