

District staff has reviewed the above referenced location and has determined the pit must be lined and fluids removed after completion. A plastic liner with the minimum thickness of 6 mil is to be used. Integrity of the liner must be maintained at all times. The fluids must be removed from the pit after workover operations have ceased.
