Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Schlichting #1-7 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 03/24/2012. This extension will expire 06/24/2012. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form.

Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date may result in a fine in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional extension will only be granted for good cause and after K.C.C. field staff has made an inspection of the site. Should field staff discover that said pit has been closed before the date of extension request, an administrative penalty may be assessed to you through K.C.C. invoice.

Vincent Oil Corporation is requesting an extension to the requirements for pit closure for the above referenced well. We are requesting a 60 day extension beyond the original required closure date of March 29th, 2012.

As you may remember from our previous discussions this well was drilled by Vincent Oil Corporation under a permit issued to Vincent Oil Corporation. Drilling and logging operations for the well were completed at approximately 10:00 AM on 4/11/2011. At that time Vincent Oil Corporation entered into an agreement with another licensed operator (Crawford Oil & Gas Co. LLC) whereby that operator agreed take over the wellbore and earn certain acreage rights upon a successful completion of the well. Unfortunately Crawford Oil & Gas Co. LLC was not successful in completing the well as a commercial producer. The well was plugged by Crawford Oil & Gas LLC under the supervision of the KCC District I field office with plugging operations being completed on or about 6/29/2011.

As you may also remember per our previous discussions because of miscommunication between the operators involved in this well free fluids do not appear to have been removed from the pit following drilling operations as was required by the permit. We are preparing some information for you review that we believe may mitigate that situation and we will provide same to you prior to final pit closure.
