


Enclosed you will find Well Plugging Application for our Schroyer #1, NW/4, Sec 12-18S-16W, Otis field, Rush County, Kansas.

According to our records, 236' of 13-3/8" surface pipe was cemented with 200 sacks; 768' of 10" intermediate string was cemented with 250 sacks, and 3515' of 7" production string was cemented with 250 sacks. This well was later squeezed between the production string and the intermediate string with an unknown amount of cement, as water began flowing between these two strings of casing.

I contacted Mr. Eldon Petty, Hays, Kansas, State Dry Hole Plugger, and he requested that we fill the casing with heavy mud to within 500' of the surface and cement from the surface to 500'. We will contact Mr. Petty before the actual plugging operation begins.


The above mentioned well had a casing leak and cement was circulated to the surface from below the Dakota formation. Therefore, no casing could be recovered. As Moss Petroleum Company owns minerals under this well and there is a possibility of secondary recovery operations in the area, it was decided to temporarily abandon this well, and the well is shut in. We hope this answers your questions in regard to your letters.
