

Dear Ms. Sobotik:

Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. Notice was examined and found to be proper per K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on January 26, 2007 concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following two sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the Arbuckle and Lansing/Kansas City formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the Arbuckle source of supply is 2 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 7 BWPD. The estimated current production from the Lansing/Kansas City source of supply is 3.85 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 24 BWPD. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is 5.85 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 7 BWPD.

Based upon the depth of the Arbuckle formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed 100 BOPD and total gas production shall not exceed 50% of the absolute open flow (AOF).

Docket Number CO010705 has been assigned to this approved application. Please use this number for well completion reports (ACO-1) and other correspondence that may concern this approved commingling.
