



Dear Mr. Marden:

Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. Notice was examined and found to be proper per K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on March 30, 2007 concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following five sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the Cherokee (Johnson zone), Pawnee (Myrick Station), Marmaton, Lansing "K" and Lansing "J" formations

The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is approximately 30 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 15 BWPD.

Based upon the depth of the **Cherokee (Johnson Zone)** formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed **200 BOPD** and total gas production shall not exceed **50%** of the absolute open flow (AOF).

Docket Number CO030701 has been assigned to this approved application. Please use this number for well completion reports (ACO-1) and other correspondence that may concern this approved commingling.
