Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. Notice was examined and found to be proper per K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on April 16, 2008 concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following two sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore:
