



Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. Notice was examined and found to be proper per K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on May 22, 2007 concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following two sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the Mississippian and Fort Scott formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the Mississippian source of supply is 5 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 50 BWPD. The estimated current production from the Fort Scott source of supply is 5 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 20 BWPD. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is 10 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 70 BWPD.

Based upon the depth of the **Mississippian** formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed **200 BOPD** and total gas production shall not exceed **50%** of the absolute open flow (AOF).

Docket Number CO050702 has been assigned to this approved application. Please use this number for well completion reports (ACO-1) and other correspondence that may concern this approved commingling.
