Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per **K.A.R. 82-3-123a**. Notice was examined and found to be proper per **K.A.R. 82-3-135a**. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on **January 8, 2007** concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following four sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the **Lansing/Kansas City, Marmaton, Morrow and Mississippian (St. Louis, Spergern)** formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the **Lansing/Kansas City** source of supply is **0 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 0 BWPD**. The estimated current production from the **Marmaton** source of supply is **0 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 0 BWPD**. The estimated current production from the **Morrow** source of supply is **14 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 70 BWPD**. The estimated current production from the **Mississippian (St. Louis, Spergern)** source of supply is **18 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 95 BWPD**. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is **32 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 165 BWPD**.

Based upon the depth of the **Mississippian (St. Louis, Spergern)** formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed **200 BOPD** and total gas production shall not exceed **50%** of the absolute open flow (AOF).
