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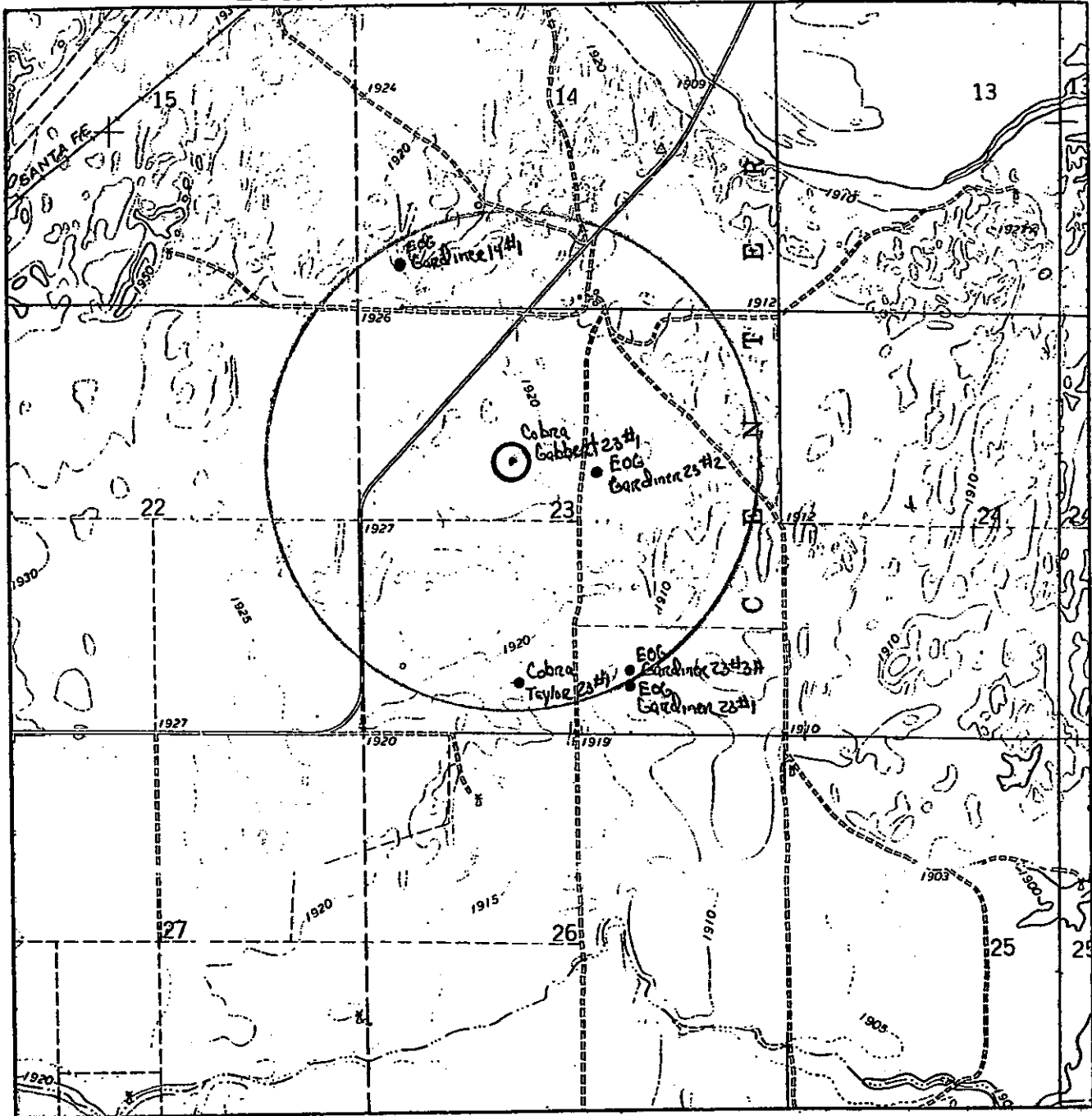

Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed Cobra Oil & Gas Corporation's Application for Well Bore Commingling of Production for the captioned well. Included is Form CDP-5, ACO-1, ACO-4, plat designating one-half mile radius around well, list of wells within the one-half mile radius with operator, wireline logs and letter attesting copy of notice sent to offset operator. Cobra Oil & Gas Corporation is requesting to commingle the Basal Chester Sand and the Chester Lime. A packer with an "X" nipple will be set between the two intervals. Tubing will be run with a sliding sleeve. This will allow either zone to be shut in to test the remaining zone.

The Basal Chester Sand has been perforated and "broken down" with 1,500 gallons of acid. Larger stimulations are being scheduled for these zones. Tubing and a packer with an "X" nipple will be run and the zone flowed back until it cleans up. A plug will then be set in the "X" nipple, tubing pulled and the Chester Lime perforated and stimulated. Tubing will be run with a sliding sleeve and the zone flowed back until it cleans up. At that point, the plug will be pulled from the packer and the zones commingled.

Upon completion of this work, Form ACO-1 will be refiled to update with stimulation and production information. The reserve pits are in the process of being closed at this time. Form CDP-4 will be filed when closure is completed.

Cobra respectfully requests that all logs and other information provided, be kept confidential for a period of one year in accordance with Kansas Corporation Commission regulations. Thank you for your consideration of this request. Should you require additional information, please advise.

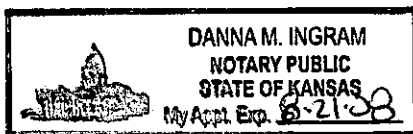

Dear Mr. Rory Edwards:


Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per **K.A.R. 82-3-123a**. This application, which was received by the KCC on **May 1, 2006** concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following **two** sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the **Chester Basal Sand** and the **Chester Lime** formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the **Chester Basal Sand** source of supply is **10 BOPD, 300 Mcfpd** and **0 BWPD**. The estimated current production from the **Chester Lime** source of supply is **400 Mcfpd** and **2 BWPD**. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is **10 BOPD, 700 Mcfpd** and **2 BWPD**. Included in this application was operator verification that the offset operators had been formally notified of this application. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period.

Based upon the depth of the **Chester Basal Sand** formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed **200BOPD** and total gas production shall not exceed **50%** of the absolute open flow (AOF).

Docket Number **CO 50602** has been assigned to this approved application. Please use this number for well completion reports (ACO-1) and other correspondence that may concern this approved commingling.
