Dear Ms. Schulte:

Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per **K.A.R. 82-3-123a**. This application, which was received by the KCC on **June 29, 2005**, concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following **two** sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the **Lansing-Kansas City** and the **Arbuckle** formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the **Lansing-Kansas City** source of supply is **3 BOPD and 1 BWPD**. The estimated current production from the **Arbuckle** source of supply is **7 BOPD and 23 BWPD**. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is **10 BOPD and 24 BWPD**. Included in this application was operator verification that the offset operators had been formally notified of this application. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period.

Based upon the depth of the **Arbuckle** formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed **100 BOPD** and total gas production shall not exceed **50%** of open flow. Docket Number **CO 060505** has been assigned to this approved application. Please use this number for well completion reports (ACO-1) and other correspondence that may concern this approved commingling.
