Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. This application, which was received by the KCC on October 12, 2005 concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following two sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the Morrow and the St. Louis formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the Morrow source of supply is 150 MCFGPD. The estimated current production from the St. Louis source of supply is 150 MCFGPD. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is 300MCFGPD. Included in this application was operator verification that the offset operators had been formally notified of this application. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period.
