Dear Mr. Estes:

Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. Notice was examined and found to be proper per K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on **July 30, 2007** concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following **two** sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the **Marmaton and Chester** formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the **Marmaton** source of supply is **6 BOPD, 3 Mcfpd and 5 BWPD**. The estimated current production from the **Chester** source of supply is **0 BOPD, 20 Mcfpd and 0 BWPD**. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is **6 BOPD, 23 Mcfpd and 5 BWPD**.

Based upon the depth of the **Chester** formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed **300 BOPD** and total gas production shall not exceed **50%** of the absolute open flow (AOF).

Docket Number **CO070702** has been assigned to this approved application. Please use this number for well completion reports (ACO-1) and other correspondence that may concern this approved commingling.
