



Dear Mr. Schraeder:

Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been technically reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. Notice was examined and found to be proper per K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on June 1, 2006 concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following two sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the Mississippian and the Snyderville formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the Mississippian source of supply is 0.5 BOPD, 7 Mcfpd and 0 BWPD. The estimated current production from the Snyderville source of supply is 0 BOPD, 23 Mcfpd and 11 BWPD. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is 0.5 BOPD, 30 Mcfpd and 11 BWPD.

Based upon the depth of the Mississippian formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed 200 BOPD and total gas production shall not exceed 50% of the absolute open flow (AOF).
