

Your "Application for Commingling" (ACO-4) for the above described well has been reviewed and approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) per K.A.R. 82-3-123a. Notice was examined and found to be proper per K.A.R. 82-3-135a. No protest had been filed within the 15-day protest period. This application, which was received by the KCC on January 15, 2008 concerns approval to simultaneously produce from the following two sources of supply through the same tubing string in the same wellbore: the Marmaton and Mississippi formations.

According to your application, the estimated current production from the Marmaton source of supply is 100 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 50 BWPD. The estimated current production from the Mississippi source of supply is 30 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 167 BWPD. The total estimated current production from all sources of supply in the subject well is 130 BOPD, 0 Mcfpd and 217 BWPD.

Based upon the depth of the **Mississippi** formation perforations, total oil production shall not exceed **200 BOPD** and total gas production shall not exceed **50%** of the absolute open flow (AOF).
