Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted a 90 day extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Hunley 1-20 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 09/13/2013. This extension will expire on 01/29/2014. Conditions should have existed within this time frame to allow closure of this drill pit. **No additional extensions will be granted.**

In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form.

Failure to close the pit prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a).


Corporation Commission:

Due to a very wet summer the completion of backfilling the **Hunley #1-20** reserve pit has been delayed.

Our reserve pit is only 40% backfilled. Langfeld Dirt Service out of Ellinwood, Kansas backfilled the working pits and our fresh water pit in January, 2013 and on the 30th of April, 2013 crowded the reserve pit.

Hutchinson Oil Co. has been in contact with the fee owner and the tenant on the delay. Cattle are currently in the pasture and Hutchinson Oil Co. has put an electric fence charger with a solar panel completely around the portion that has not been back-filled.

Hutchinson Oil Co. would like to request an extension so that the pit can thoroughly dry out before backfilling. Hutchinson Oil Co. will continue to crowd the pit to expedite the process.
