NCRA apparently farmed out the lease to Fred B. Anschutz, who in turn let turn-key drilling contract to Terrel Drilling and Producing Company. The contract made Terrel Drilling and Producing responsible for leveling the location. Under date of August 5, 1964, Mr. Anschutz' secretary called this division and advised that Mr. Joe K. Branum of Terrel Drilling and Producing had informed their office that the location leveling work had been completed.

Sir:

I own the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of 34-33-7 Harper County, Kansas. In January of this year (1964) a test well for oil was drilled on the land. It was a dry hole.

I am writing with reference to the filling-in of slush pits and ponds at the well site. I have contacted the lessee several times relative to filling and leveling, but have gotten no action. These pits and ponds are unsanitary and dangerous. Can your office do anything about it?
