
Dear Sir or Madam:

According to our files we do not have an application for the above referenced workover pit, district staff gave verbal approval on 05/02/2013. According to K.A.R. 82-600(b) workover pits may be permitted through verbal authorization from the appropriate district office subject to the filing of a surface pond application within **five days** after the verbal authorization.

Effective April 1, 2013 all operators must file all available forms through Kolar (Kansas On-Line Automated Reporting) at <https://kolar.kgs.ku.edu>. If this pit has been closed please complete the closure of surface pit form (CDP-4) also. Please complete the filing process within 14 days of this letter.
