This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an additional extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Osage #19-04H well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 03/13/2013. This extension will expire on 05/01/2014. Conditions should have existed within this time frame to allow closure of this drill pit. **No additional extensions will be granted.**


In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form.

Failure to close the pit prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a).

Dear Ms. Haynes,

I am writing to request an additional extension of the pit closure for the above referenced wells.

In the letters dated 10/23/2013, it was noted that fluids should be dewatered and disposed of in an authorized disposal facility. Much of the water has since evaporated, and the pits have begun to be crowded; but the snowfall during the month of December and the extreme cold temperatures that affected the area in the past couple of weeks have hampered additional efforts.

Now that conditions have improved, our field guys have resumed working to remove the remaining water and are working with the schedule of a contract company to finish crowding the pits.

I recognize that the previous letters stated that additional extension would not be granted, but Osage would greatly appreciate an additional 15 days to finalize closing these two pits.
