Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an additional extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Hunley #1-20 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 09/13/2013. This extension will expire on 03/13/2014. Conditions should have existed within this time frame to allow closure of this drill pit. **No additional extensions will be granted.**

In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form.

Failure to close the pit prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a).


