To Whom It May Concern:

Two (2) working pits were utilized for two (2) pluggings that took place in March 2014 for the above-captioned. The pit applications (CDP-1) for the B.I. Schmeidler #3 and Herman #3 were approved on March 25th and March 27th, respectively. I am writing this letter to inform you at this time the working pits for both wells remain open.

The recent heavy rains and resulting muddy conditions in Ellis County have made closing both pits impractical at this time. Given the conditions, we respectfully request an extension for closing the pits. We still expect to close both pits in the next thirty (30) days. Please let us know if this time frame is acceptable.

Please note we have been in contact with Mr. Pat Staab from the District #4 office and will continue to update him on any progress. Mr. Staab oversaw the pluggings and has since been out to inspect the pits. Additionally, we will file on KOLAR as soon as the pits have been backfilled.
