RE: Oil Allowables For Nonprorated  
Oil Wells- Application To Herd #1

Dear Mr. Patton:

As a result of a lease inspection conducted back on May 31<sup>st</sup> of this year, it has come to our attention that the Herd #1 well may be exceeding its daily oil allowable. To refresh your memory concerning the allowable regulation, for the depth range of **4001-6000 ft.**, the allowable is set at 200 Bbls/Day. [See regulation **K.A.R. 82-3-203**]

We believe that this depth range covers the production interval of the Herd well.

Please take action to immediately restrict the Herd well to the aforementioned 200 bbls/Day rate.

A Field Agent from our Dodge City District Office will be monitoring the oil production from this Herd well in order to insure that the rate gets cut back. Please give your pumper instructions to cooperate fully with the KCC Agent while he is on the lease.

To obtain an oil allowable greater than the standard allowable prescribed in the statewide regulations, you will have to make application through an attorney to the Commission for what we term a "**special allowable**" for good cause demonstrated.
