Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an additional extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the V & V 1 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 01/22/2014. This extension will expire 09/01/2014. **No additional extensions will be granted.** In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form.

Failure to close the pit prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a).

Our ninety (90) days extension to close the drilling pits on the above referenced location will expire on the 22nd of July, 2014.
