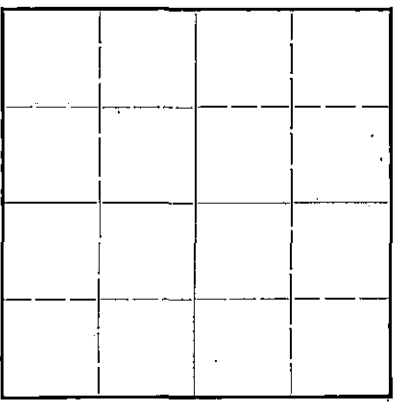

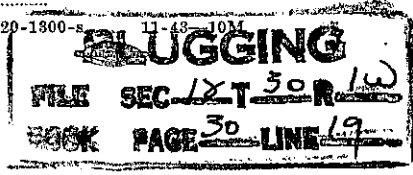

TESTING AND ACIDIZING REPORT

No show of oil or gas while cleaning out to bottom and drilling to 3890'. Fair looking sand from 3890' to 3895'. Some free oil showed up after hole setting for 15 hours. No show of formation water. Possibly 5 galls. of nice clean free oil in 24 hours, no increase of fluid while drilling to 3909'. Approximately 5 galls. of water per hour from 3909' to 3919', no increase in oil. No increase of oil or water while drilling to 3950'. 1950' fill up of water no noticeable increase of oil while drilling from 3950' to 3955', approximately 45 minutes time.
