Dear Mr. Ogden:

On Dec. 22nd. 1958 Mr. Clyde Thompson with West-Homa Oil Co. called me for plugging orders, but that they had a few feet more to drill. On Dec. 23, I went to the well and the pumps had broken down, and were just getting ready to start drilling. They gave me pipe set at 13 3/8 at 501, circulated with cement, 9 5/8 at 2906 the survey showed top of cement at 700 /. I told them that I could see no reason to leave the recoverable pipe in the hole, and they could either pull the pipe over the rotary or cap it and get a pipe pulling machine to do the work and in either case call me when they were ready. Dec. 28th I called the office in Hooker to find out what had been done and was told they had moved the rotary rig off, filled the hole with heavy mud and welded a steel cap on top, and that they were on a deal to & drill the hole deeper. I gave permission to leave the hole as was, as temporary abandoned, with your approval, and to send you a letter with all the information, and to send me a copy. Not hearing on Feb.5th I called them and they said they would send it right away. Received a plugging application and Plugging report also copy of the letter. As I have never approved this well as plugged, only temporily, I did not mail in a report. Hoping this meets with your approval.
