Dear Operator:

This letter is to notify you that the Conservation Division has received your plugging proposal, form CP-1, for the above well and has reviewed the proposal for completeness. The central office will now forward your CP-1 to the district office listed below for review of the proposed plugging method. **Please contact the district office for approval of your proposed plugging method at least five (5) days before plugging the well, pursuant to K.A.R. 82-3-113(b). If a workover pit will be used during the plugging of the well it must be permitted. A CDP-1 form must be filed and approved prior to the use of the pit in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-600.**

The Conservation Division's review of form CP-1, either in the central or district office, does not include an inquiry into well ownership or the filing operator's legal right to plug the well. This notice in no way constitutes authorization to plug the above well by persons not having legal rights of ownership or interest in the well.

This notice is void after January 25, 2016. The CP-1 filing does not bring the above well into compliance with K.A.R. 82-3-111 with regard to the Commission's temporary abandonment requirements.

JOURNAL ENTRY OF DEFAULT JUDGMENT


NOW on this 13th day of September, 2013, this matter comes on for default judgment. The plaintiffs appear by and through their attorney, Randall C. Henry. The defendant appears neither in person nor by counsel. The court after being fully advised in the premises finds as follows:

1. The petition of the plaintiffs herein was filed on June 17, 2013, and personally served on the resident agent for the defendant, Pat Anderson, on June 20, 2013.
2. Since the service of process over two months ago the defendant has filed no responsive pleading, has not requested any extension of time to plead and is therefore wholly in default.
3. The court finds that the saltwater disposal lease covering the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 3 West,

McPherson County, Kansas being incorporated in Exhibit A and B to plaintiff's petition is hereby terminated based upon the default alleged in plaintiff's petition which is uncontroverted.

4. The court further finds that the defendant shall possess no interest in said saltwater disposal agreement and lease and that pursuant to the terms of said lease agreement and particularly Section 4 (b) all equipment and personal property on said saltwater lease hereby reverts to the ownership of the plaintiffs herein and that defendant shall have no further claim of ownership or possession to any of the equipment.
5. Any rights to operate said saltwater disposal well held by the defendant pursuant to the terms of said lease agreement are hereby terminated forthwith.
