To whom it may concern:


In September 2002, I had a gas well drilled 600 feet from my house, however it resulted in a dry well (no gas). This well was plugged according to regulations. I had previously known of a gas well to the north of my home, 25 feet off of my north property line. I contacted the owner, John Hotz, in an attempt to purchase the gas well. In discussions with him, he stated that some of the gas it produced was probably coming off of our property anyway. Mr. Hotz agreed to let me use the gas well. I applied for an operator license for a residential well and was granted the license at that time. Mr. Hotz asked for me to get the gas well surveyed, which I did. A licensed surveyor completed the measurements and the results were taken to Mr. Hotz's attorney in Girard, as I was directed. Several weeks later, I checked on the progress and was told that it was not completed. I left it with the attorney to contact me with further instructions. I was never contacted.

In August 2014, Mr. Hotz informed me by a letter that he no longer wanted me using the well. He said that he was getting on in years and was going to clean up his properties. At that time, he stated that he would plug the well and that I should make other arrangements for fuel for my home. I made arrangements for delivery of a liquid propane tank and the fuel and I changed my appliances accordingly.

I now understand that Mr. Hotz wants the State or me to plug the well. Since I am the operator with the license, even though I have not had the use of the well for over one year, I understand that according to Kansas statute it is my responsibility to have the well plugged. Had I known that Mr. Hotz was not going to follow through with his statements to me about plugging the well, as the license holder, I would have started plugging proceedings after receiving his letter in August 2014.

I have made preliminary arrangements with W and W Production Company in Chanute, KS to plug the well. After I receive notice of your approval, I will make final arrangements with them. They informed me that it would be approximately two weeks after I notify them until they would arrive.
