There is 222' of 5 1/2" surface casing cement circulated. The anhydrite was at 1206', all fresh water is behind surface. 1st plug at 480' they pumped down 3 Sbs of bulls + 3 Sbs of gells + 50 Sbs of cement filling hole to 0'. The Plugging was accomplished by Halliburton Co. The Cement used was Common with 3% gells 2% C.C.
