This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an additional extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Barnhart 1-19 well.

This extension will expire 10/28/2015. **No additional extensions will be granted.** In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form, **but not the time period for filing the waste transfer form (CDP-5).**

*Failure to close the pit prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a).*

Our first extension of time to close the pits on the subject well is expiring on July 28, 2015. The working pits and fresh water pit have been closed in the last 30 days and a bigger berm has been built around the reserve pit. Two loads of water have been pulled from the reserve pit and disposed of in an effort to expedite the drying out process for the reserve pit. The reserve pit remains too wet to close at this time. We have been coordinating these efforts with the KCC's field agent in this area, Ken Jehlik. Would you please give us another 90 day extension of time and we will continue to try to close these pits completely as soon as possible.

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Barnhart 1-19 well.



Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form, **but not the time period for filing the waste transfer form (CDP-5).**

*Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional pit extension may be renewed upon request, but no pit permit extension shall be extended beyond six months after the original deadline.*

Please accept my apologies for allowing the time allotted to close the pits on this hole to expire without closure or an application for an extension of time. The working pits, fresh water pit and the reserve pit are not closed yet. There is, as you might expect, significant rain water in the pits now that needs to dry. The contractor we have hired to do this work, W & L Dirt Contractors and they have been unable to even begin the work because they had been busy trying to close pits in irrigation circles before the farmers started irrigating. We are making an honest effort to get this work done. The weather hasn't been cooperating. Would you please give us another 180 day extension of time and we will make every effort to close these pits completely as quickly as possible.
