Operator:

A review of your recent correspondence and/or our files indicates that the referenced pit remains open, and that a further extension of time to close the pit is not available to you. The pit is or was required to be closed by January 16, 2015.

If you wish to obtain an exception to K.A.R. 82-3-602, you will need to file a formal application and publish notice under K.A.R. 82-3-100. Note that the application may or may not be granted. You may contact our legal department if you have questions about that process.

If the referenced pit is not closed along with a Surface Pit Closure ("CDP-4") Form submitted, or alternatively if a formal application has not been filed, by **July 23, 2015**, staff may make a penalty recommendation to the Commission, which may result in a monetary fine.

Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Medicine River Ranch E 2 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 08/16/2014. This extension will expire on 1/16/2015. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form, **but not the time period for filing the waste transfer form (CDP-5).**

Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional pit extension may be renewed upon request, but no pit permit extension shall be extended beyond six months after the original deadline.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Re: Surface Pit Closure Form(s) - ("CDP-4")

Operator:

Commission records indicate that for the well(s) on the attached list, you filed an Application for Surface Pit (CDP-1) form for each well along with your Intent to Drill.

If any drilling pits remain open, they must be closed.

Since no CDP-4 is on file for the well(s), you are in violation of K.A.R. 82-3-602(c).

We have not received the necessary Surface Pit Closure Form(s).

Commission records indicate that the well(s) were spudded more than 13 months ago.

Under K.A.R. 82-3-602, drilling pits must be closed within 12 months after the spud date of the well.

Further, an operator must submit a CDP-4 within 1 month after closing a pit.

**Failure to submit a complete, accurate CDP-4
for the pit(s) associated with the well(s) on the attached list
by OCTOBER 16, 2014
shall be punishable by a \$100 per-well administrative penalty.**

The information requested above must be submitted on KOLAR. If a CDP-4 is returned to you as incomplete, you do not have additional time - the deadline above governs.
