Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Addington A 3-14 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 05/27/2015. This extension will expire on 8/27/2015. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form, **but not the time period for filing the waste transfer form (CDP-5).**

*Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional pit extension may be renewed upon request, but no pit permit extension shall be extended beyond six months after the original deadline.*

Dear Ms. Rains:

I am writing you as a follow up to our telephone conversation today. The above captioned well was spud May 23, 2014 and to-date we have closed the working pits and we have crowded the reserve pit to the point we have effectively closed about 90% of the total original pit area.

We had been on schedule to close the remainder of the pit this week ahead of the deadline, but at this point, the remainder portion of the pit is too wet to close due to rains during the past two weeks. We do not want to risk the problems and liability potentially associated with premature closure of a wet pit and upsetting the surface owner.

Please take this letter as our formal request for a three (3) month extension to finalize the pit closure. While requesting a three month extension our intention is to close the pits as soon as practical which we anticipate would likely be within 30 days. As required, we will submit the CDP-4 pit closure form once the finalization of the pit closure occurs.

Thank you in advance for your assistance with this pit closure extension request.
