Abandonment procedure of pit:

Liquid contents allowed to evaporate, pit then backfilled after it was dry enough to restore to original condition. This took some time because we had a couple of rains that kept putting us behind on this project. We had a representative from the local KCC office come out before we closed the pits to make sure everything was acceptable.



Attached please find a completed, signed and notarized, CDP-4 Surface Pond Closure Form for the above referenced well. As I mentioned during our phone conversation on Monday, April 25, 2005, I do not have an explanation as to why this form was not sent into your office previously. I looked through my files and found forms on over 20 other wells we've drilled since then and all of them had the completed forms. As per your suggestion I did estimate the closure date, I'm fairly certain that I'm close on the time of year. I remember having some trouble getting the area dry enough to close due to some rains as we were getting ready to close the pits. We were running close to our year time frame, for closing the pits and the landowner was trying to push us to get it done so he could plant fall crops in that area as well, which was another reason we were trying to get it completed. One of the men from the local KCC office came out and said they were dry enough to backfill, but it's been so long ago I can't remember who that would have been. Generally the minute I get the bill I go ahead and fill it out, so I don't forget, but I don't show a copy on record so it must have slipped by me somehow. I apologize for this failure and appreciate your time in visiting with me about this and helping me to the correct solution.
