


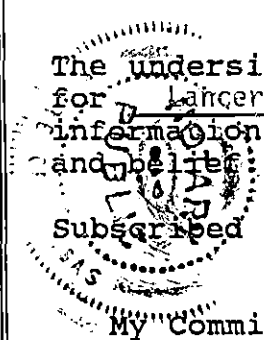

THE EXPENSE INCURRED, INCLUDING MILEAGE AND STAFF TIME, WILL BE CHARGED TO THE OPERATOR.
