Dear Charles N. Griffin:

This letter is correction to letter that was issued on Kolar. District staff has inspected the above referenced location and has determined that the reserve pit shall be constructed without slots, the bottom shall be flat and reasonably level and the free fluids must be removed. The fluids are to be removed from the reserve pit as soon as the Hutchinson Salt section has been drilled through and displacement of the fluids into the reserve pit has occurred. The fluids should be removed again within 96 hours after drilling operations have ceased.

Keep pits away from draw/drainage. Keep pit out of draw and up on hill tops to west or east away from draw. Steel working pits are to be used at stake.

If production casing is set all completion fluids shall be removed from the working pits daily. NO completion fluids or non-exempt wastes shall be placed in the reserve pit.

The fluids should be taken to an authorized disposal well. Please file form CDP-5 (August 2004), Exploration and Production Waste Transfer, through KOLAR within 30 days of fluid removal.
