Date and hour plugging is desired to begin March 20, 1942 8:00 A.M.

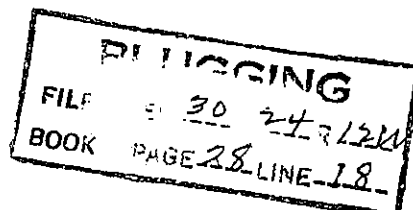

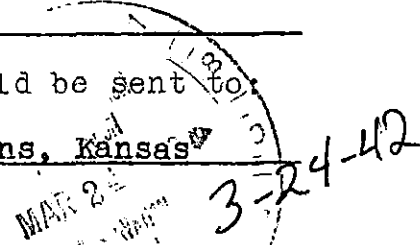
