Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Kozisek 5 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 7/14/2016. This extension will expire on 12/19/2016. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form, **but not the time period for filing the waste transfer form (CDP-5).**

*Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional pit extension may be renewed upon request, but **no pit permit extension shall be extended beyond six months after the original deadline.***



Good morning Jonelle, wanted to notify you of a potential letter of request for extension of time that may come your way. Operator is Logan, Leslie dba L.B. Oil and it's for the Kozisek #5 in the SE/4 of 18-16-10W. EW. Co.

Well was spud on 7-14-2015.

Operator is in violation of failure to close any pit or file an extension with the prescribed time limit.

District 2 Field staff would ask that you deny the request for an extension of time due to Virgil's discovery of miscellaneous solid waste left in reserve pit. Operator has been granted additional time to remove solid waste from pit, deadline to remove material is August 14th. And I am writing up a recommendation for a commission order for failure to close the pit.
