Gentlemen:

In reply to yours of May 10, regarding the above captioned well, please be advised that The Kansas Power and Light Company did intend to plug the P. A. Decker No. 2, however, as you know, the Shell Oil Corporation owns one half of the Decker Lease.

According to the contract between The Kansas Power and Light Company and Shell, The Kansas Power and Light Company must tender the wells to Shell for disposition before plugging, and in this instance, Shell decided to take over the P.A. Decker No. 2, therefore, so far as The Kansas Power and Light Company is concerned, the final disposition will be Shell's problem.

With regards to the E.P. Wedel No. 1 Gas Well, Shell advised The Kansas Power and Light Company that they did not want to purchase the Wedel Well, but a group of the Royalty owners on the Wedel Lease have indicated that they would like to purchase the well, and at this time, we are waiting on their decision.

We will advise you as soon as a definite decision is made.
