This old hole was originally drilled during 1929 or 1930 to a depth of 1545 feet. The well was drilled by a Greenwood County Operator and cattleman, a Mr. John Rogers. Apparently Mr. Rogers was another victim of the 1929 depression and he hung himself on the rig when the hole had reached 1545'. We have no record of the well aside from this information that was furnished by Mr. F. G. Holl.
