Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge the receipt of your letter of April 21, 1953 asking to be furnished with a copy of the well log on the Christiansen Well No. 1 located NW SW NW of Section 10-21-12W, Stafford County, Kansas.

In compliance with this request we would like to refer you to our Well Plugging application form filed March 25, 1953, wherein we stated the well log was not filed with the application and then by way of explanation, we offered the information that the well was originally drilled and produced by the Diszer Investment Company, Great Bend, Kansas and later produced by the A & A Oil Company, Great Bend, Kansas, and that the well was drilled in June 1951. Hilton Drilling Company, Incorporated purchased the equipment on the lease and assumed the responsibility of plugging the well and cleaning up the lease. We do not have in our possession any of the original records on the well and are therefore unable to furnish the well log as requested by you.
