This letter is to inform you that you have been granted an extension of time in which to close the drilling pits associated with the Fischer 1-4 well.

The original 365 days for closure expired on 06/21/2017. This extension will expire on 09/21/2017. We urge you to make every effort to close these pits within this time frame. In the event there is water standing in these pits, please dewater and dispose of fluids in an authorized disposal facility to expedite closure. Extension of this time frame automatically extends the time period for filing the closure of surface pit form, but not the time period for filing the waste transfer form (CDP-5).

Failure to close the pit or request an additional extension prior to the expiration date shall result in a monetary penalty in accordance with K.A.R. 82-3-602(a). An additional pit extension may be renewed upon request, but no pit permit extension shall be extended beyond six months after the original deadline.

Vincent Oil Corporation is requesting an extension to the requirements for pit closure for the reserve pit associated with the above referenced well. We are requesting a 90 day extension beyond the original required closure date of June 21, 2017.

We have, as evidenced by the attached invoice for work performed at the site, restored the wellsite, but have not as of yet completed closure of the reserve pit.
